


Two Ways To Order A Test




**Understanding How to Order The

How Tests Enter the MGI System



**Mom Orders Directly
From MGI**



**Practitioner Orders
For Their Client**



**Both Pathways
Lead To The Same
Interpretation Process**

Path A:

Mom Orders Directly

- **Mom purchases test from the MGI website**
- **Kit is shipped to her home**
- **She collects sample + mails it back**
- **MGI receives results**
- **MGI creates her maternal report**

Path B: Practitioner Orders for Client

- Practitioner logs into MGI portal
- Orders at practitioner pricing
- Kit ships to client
- MGI receives results
- MGI creates maternal report
- Practitioner supports the delivery session

What MGI Handles for BOTH Paths

- **Manages the test pipeline**
- **Receives and verifies results**
- **Extracts maternal pathways**
- **Builds the MGI Maternal Report**
- **Delivers report + next steps via email to the mother**

What Practitioners Handle

- **Reassurance + communication with clients**
- **Scheduling the report review session**
- **Delivering the MGI report safely**
- **Supporting the mom's next step**
- **Staying within scope**
- **Guiding implementation conversations**


TURNAROUND TIME

Typical timeline:

- **Ordering → 1-3 business days**
 - **Kit delivery → 3-7 days**
 - **Processing → 2-3 weeks**
- **MGI report creation → 2-5 business days**

Times may vary by location + lab load.

Practitioner Notifications



Practitioners are notified when:

- **Kit ships**
- **Sample is received**
- **Lab finishes processing**
- **MGI report is ready**
- **Client is ready for next step**

MGI verifies:

- Correct client identity
- Report completeness
- Pathway organization
- Maternal relevance
- No clinical or diagnostic claims
